

Seminar on "Earthquake Resistant Materials"

PSF in collaboration with Pakistan Materials Research Society (PMRS) and University of Azad Jammu & Kashmir (AJ&K) organized an international seminar on "Earthquake-Resistant Materials" at Hotel Margala, Islamabad from Sep. 11 to 12, 2006. A number of national and international experts/ speakers gave talks on geology of earthquakes, safety and security from devastation of earthquakes, design of earthquake resistant structures and the types of materials that are safe for construction in earthquake areas. The seminar was inaugurated by Dr. Ishfaq Ahmad, Special Advisor to the Prime Minister of Pakistan. It was concluded with the warning of likely threat of another earthquake on the basis of geological study of the area. It was also mentioned that the underground activities have been recorded, as the fault line is active in Balakot, Bagh and many other parts of NWFP and northern Punjab. The recommendations were prepared for onward submission to relevant public sector departments for implementation.

Collaboration with French Institutions

A meeting was held at PSF on Sep. 9, 2006 to explore the possibilities of collaboration between research institutions of Pakistan and France with particular reference to the development and promotion of Dairy Science in Pakistan. Dr. Sonia Darracq, Higher Education & Scientific Attache, Embassy of France, Dr. Frederic Gaucheron and Pr Jean-Francois, Professors of Dairy Science from Agrocampus, Rennes, France attended the meeting. Dr. N. M. Butt, Chairman, Dr. S. Azhar Hasan, Member Science, Dr. Manzoor H. Soomro, Chief Scientific Officer, PSF and Prof. M. Faqir Anjum Chaudhry, Director, Institute of Food Science & Technology, University of Agriculture, Faisalabad participated from PSF.

After detailed discussions, two activities were planned to be jointly organized in Pakistan: 1) Holding of Workshops on "Dairy Products" and "Nutrition" in Nov. 2006 and July, 2007; and 2) Popularization of Dairy Science & Nutrition, through PSF Science Caravans working in all provinces. Further, Dr. Sonia was briefed about other activities of the Foundation, in her follow-up visit to PSF on Sep. 13, 2006.

US-Pak Natural Science Linkage Programme

A meeting of PSF Technical Committee on Agricultural Sciences was held on August 19, 2006, wherein the research areas were prioritized, as summarized below:

Collection, Characterization and Evaluation of Genetic Material; Crop Protection; Post-Harvest Handling; Natural Resource Management; Plant and Animal Improvement; Farm Mechanization; and Bio-Informatics.

Research Support Programme

Meeting of the Technical Committee in Engineering Sciences was held, wherein one new project and 21 progress reports were approved. Hence, Rs.4.39m were released on account of due instalments.

Financial Support for Holding Conferences/ Seminars/ Workshops: Rs.375,000 were released to eight organizations for holding science conferences, seminars & workshops.

Awards/ Fellowships to Ph.D/ M.Phil Students:

Rs.72,000 were released to Gomal University, D.I. Khan on account of Fellowship grant to two Ph.D Students.

Development Activities

The processing of the proposals/ requests under the projects "Funding of S&T Research in Universities and other R&D Organizations" and "Financial Support to Scientific Societies in Pakistan" is being carried out. However, the funds for the first quarter of current financial year have not been received from MoST.

Science Popularization Activities

Federal and Provincial Science Caravan units organized seven Science Exhibitions, Film & Planetarium Shows in schools of their respective areas. More than 5500 students and general public visited these exhibitions.

National S&T Expo-2006

In connection with the inauguration of National Memorial Museum established at Shakar Paryan, Islamabad under the directives of the President of Pakistan, PSF is organizing "National S&T Expo-2006". More than twenty S&T organizations are taking part in this exhibition. PSF being the focal organization is coordinating with various organizations and several meetings have been held in PSF and PMNH. Documentaries highlighting the achievements of participating organizations are also being prepared in collaboration with Lok Virsa Museum.

In continuation of the UNESCO project "Breaking the Poverty Cycle of Women" the PSF has signed "FEE Contract" with UNESCO, Islamabad for the fourth phase of the project, under which four booklets on various topics for neo-literates and a pictorial booklet on water issues for all participating countries would be prepared.

Workshop on "Media and Science Awareness in the Knowledge Society"

To ensure better coverage of science in media, a workshop on "Media and Science Awareness in the Knowledge Society" was organized by PASTIC at Pakistan Forest Institute, Peshawar from Sep. 5-6, 2006. The workshop was inaugurated by Mr. Asif Iqbal Daudzai, Provincial Minister for Information and Public Relations, N.W.F.P. It was aimed at providing a forum for scientists and media practitioners to discuss related issues and evolve the promoting for public awareness understanding of scientific basis of events, as the informed public is an invaluable resource for any nation. The workshop involved 44 scientists, journalists, television producers, public relation persons and people working for the propagation of science in society.

A roundtable discussion moderated by Dr. Haroon Rasheed, Vice Chancellor, University of Peshawar was held, wherein the eminent scientists and media personalities discussed the importance of scientific literacy and the problems faced in presenting sciencerelated activities. Based on these discussions, following action items were identified:

- Training of media personnel and introduction of science journalism in the departments of journalism and mass communication.
- Need of interaction between scientists and journalists through regular forums/ exhibitions.
- Allocation of space/ time for coverage of S&T in print/ electronic media. Pakistan Newspapers Society/ Pakistan Broadcasting Association would be approached for this purpose.
- PSF was desired to convey the results of PSF funded research projects to the media.

The concluding session was presided by Dr. N.M. Butt, Chairman PSF, wherein the certificates and shields were distributed to the participants and resource persons.
